Key dates

- **1945** the end of WW2
- **1948** (June 22nd) The HMT Empire Windrush ship from Jamaica docks at Tilbury, London.
- **1948** The British Nationality Act gives people who live in the British Empire the right to live in the UK.
- **1948** The NHS is created. Thousands of nurses from the West Indies will be recruited.
- **1968** Racial discrimination in housing, jobs and banking is made illegal. There are rising racial attacks on Black and Asian people in the UK.
- **2012** The arrival of the Windrush is celebrated in the opening ceremony of the 2012 London Olympic games.
- **2018** (June 22nd) The first Windrush Day is commemorated.
