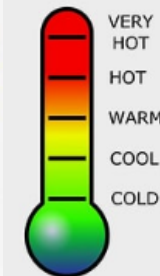


Growing healthy plants

Mature plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow in to healthy plants.



What happens if you do not water a plant?

If a plant has not been watered, its' leaves and stem will become floppy and droopy and the roots will be dry. The water inside the plant keeps it stiff and upright.



Comparative enquiry

A comparative test enquiry is where we compare one condition with another, for example:

Water and no water
Light and dark

Pattern seeking enquiry

When a test is carried out in a natural setting, it can be difficult to tell if results are due to different conditions such as light or temperature or both. This type of test, where you cannot control every condition is called a pattern seeking enquiry.
