## Michaelangelo 1475-1564 Picasso 1881-1973

**Michelangelo** was an Italian artist who made realistic paintings and sculptures, like the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel.

**Picasso** was a Spanish artist who used shapes and bright colours to create fun, abstract art.

**What do they have in common?** Both were famous artists who used imagination. They made portraits - Michelangelo's looked real, Picasso's were playful and full of shapes. Their art is still loved and studied today.
