- **Fold** - Bending paper or material to make shapes or lines.
- **Crumple** - Scrunching paper to make texture or pattern.
- **Overlay** - Putting one layer or material on top of another.
- **Depth** - Making some parts look closer or further away in a picture.
- **Layers** - Using more than one layer of colour, paint, or material.
- **Tone** - How light or dark a colour looks.
- **Mood** - The picture gives, like calm, or sad.
